



Exotic Food Culture

Another reason to study abroad in Denmark is to experience the country's unique food culture. American and Italian influences can be seen in Denmark with pastas, barbecues, and salad bars. As a student, getting to experience these traditional dishes with locals is part of the immersion process.





Wildlife / National Parks

Elk, boars, wolves, and brown bears frequent the terrains of Denmark. The University of Copenhagen offers an incredible Animal Science program, which is taught in English. Many universities, like Copenhagen, offer work permits for international students. If you're studying zoology or an animal related career, the National Park Service may be hiring student help. It would be a great opportunity to work with such unique wildlife.

Diverse Geography / Outdoor Activities

The outdoor activities which can be found here are unique and fascinating to international students. Caving is a popular activity in Jutland, where three abandoned mines are now open to the public.





Events / Festivals

The Aalborg Carnival is the largest carnival in Northern Europe, with over 60,000 participants and over 100,000 onlookers. Within the carnival is the Grand Parade, which ends in a large-scale party of colors in the city.



Denmark is a gold mine for students wishing to study history, anthropology, geography, the social sciences, and many more. For those seeking contemporary thrills, The Tivoli Gardens is also situated in Copenhagen.

What is an AP degree?


A 2-year full-time programme providing a solid foundation of theory combined with practical experience.

What is a Top-up Bachelor?

A 1 to 1.5-year full- time programme building on a 2-year AP degree or equivalent from another country, leading to a Bachelor degree.







Entry Requirements

Academics- AP degree-

InternationalBaccalaureate Diploma with minimum 60% with Maths and English as mandatory subjects

Top-up- 2 years AP degree or 3 years bachelor's with minimum 65% in relevant field. Maths and English mandatory as subjects.


Master's- Bachelor's degree with minimum 60% in relevant Field

MBA- Bachelor's degree with minimum 60% + minimum two years relevant management experience

IELTS- 6.5 with no band less than 6.0



Duration of the programs and Tuition Fee

AP Degree- 24 months
Top-up- 12 to 18 months
Master's- 12 months
MBA- 15 months

Tuition Fees-

DKK 55,000 to DKK 95,000 (6 to 11 Lakhs in INR)

Application Fee- For University College of Northern Denmark- 100 Euro For IBA Kolding- DKK 750 (9000 Rs. approx. in INR)

Deadlines for Application

University College of Northern Denmark- AP Degree- 15th March

Top-up- 1st July

IBA Kolding- 15th June
