Ireland Map

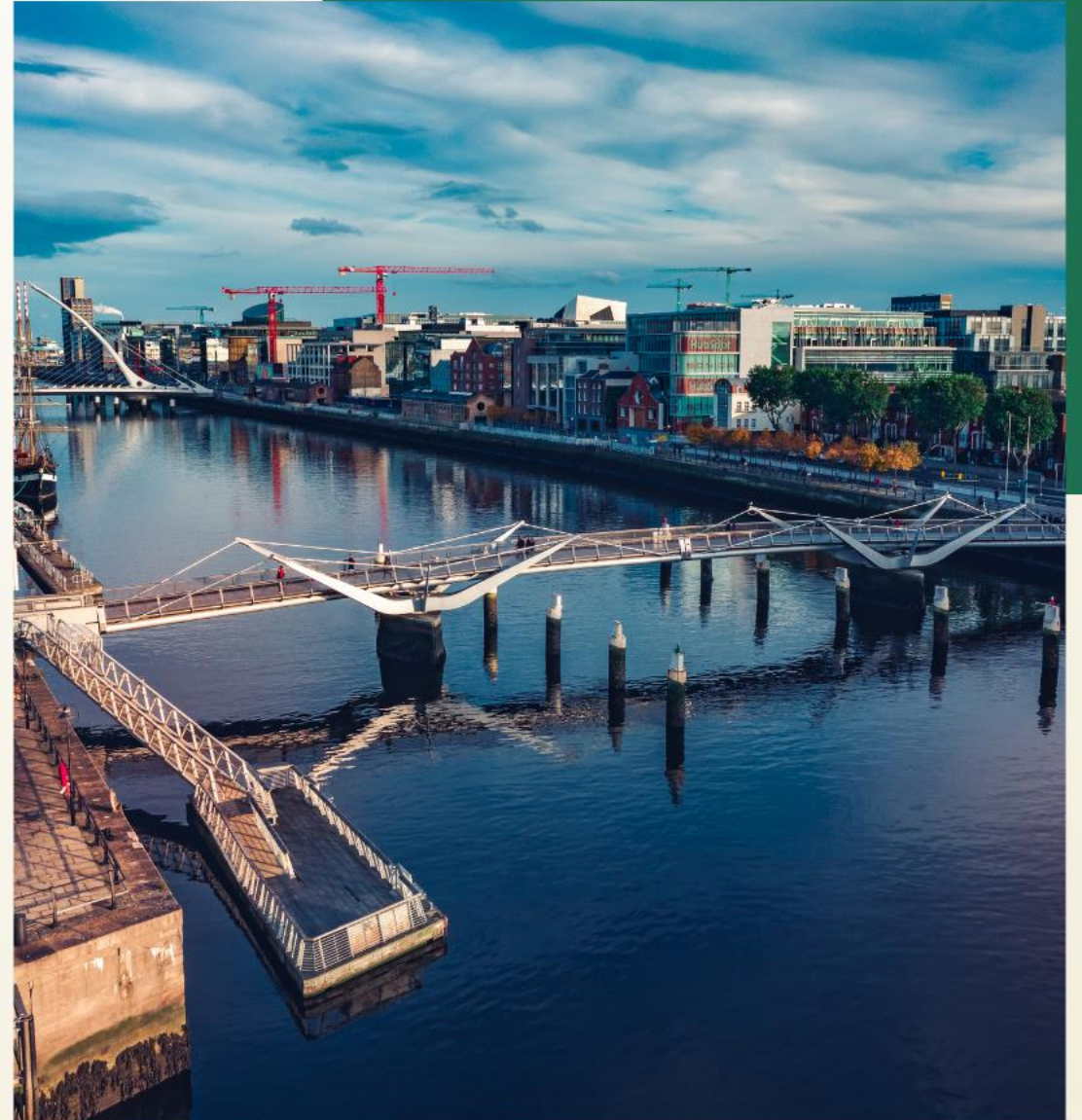

- ▶ Ireland is located in the north-west of Europe.
- ▶ Politically, Ireland is divided between the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland, a part of the United Kingdom.
- ▶ Capital of Ireland is **Dublin**. Cork, Galway, Maynooth & Limerick are some of the popular cities of Ireland.
- ▶ Official language of Ireland is Irish and English.

- ▶ Flight duration from *Mumbai/Delhi* to *Dublin*: 12 hrs. 30 mins.



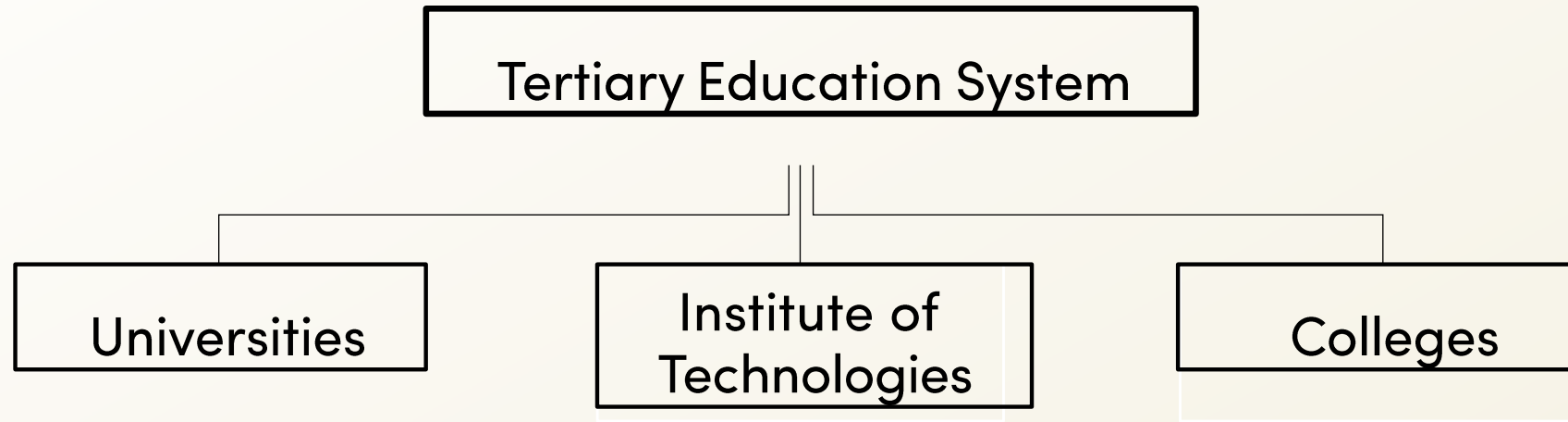
Why Study in Ireland?

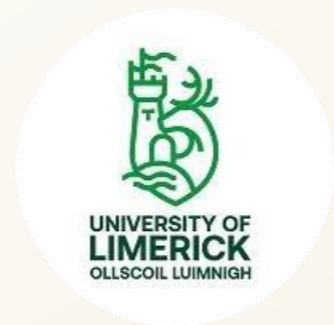

- **Trinity College Dublin:** €40 for MBA and €55 for other courses
- **National University of Ireland Galway:** €35 (PG)
- **Dublin City University:** €50 (PG) for MSc Management (Business) and MSc Computing
- **University College Cork:** €45 (UG) & €50 (PG)
- **University of Limerick:** €35 (PG)
- **Maynooth University:** €50 (PG)



Entry Criteria



▶ **Bachelors:**

Minimum **70%-90%** in class 12th for Universities, **70%** in class 12th for Institute of Technologies and **55%-60%** in class 12th for Colleges

▶ **Masters :**

Minimum **55%-75%** in Graduation with IELTS **6.5*** with no band less than 6.0. IELTS **6** with no band less than 5.5 is also acceptable in some Universities, Institute of Technologies and Colleges.

- ▶ **Dublin Business School** offers 2 months pre-sessional English Language course if the student is having IELTS 6 with no band less than 5.5 and the overall requirement is 6.5 bands.

Bachelors Honours Degree	Level 8	12 months
Masters Degree/ Postgraduate Diploma	Level 9	24 months



Employment Permit Schemes

▶ **Work Permit (General Work Permit)**

- Allows a non-EU citizen to work legally in Ireland for an employer in a particular occupation.
- Individual must have annual Salary above € 30,000 to qualify for work permit.
- The permit is Initially Granted for 2 years and can be renewed for further period of 3 years.
- The work permit can be issued indefinitely after a period of 5 years.

▶ **Ireland Green Card(Critical Skill Employment Permit)**

- Allows skilled individuals to work in Ireland for a specified employer in an occupation where skills shortages exist.
- Individual must have annual Salary above € 60,000 to qualify for Green Card permit.
- The permit is Initially Granted for 2 years.
- After 2 years, immigrants may apply for a Stamp 4 which allows them to live and work in Ireland on a permanent basis.



VISAS

Normal Visa

- Applications must be lodged at the VFS centre at least **6 weeks** prior to proposed dates of travel.
- Student must have an unconditional offer and he/she should pay a **minimum deposit of 6000 Euros if fee is 12000 Euros or less and 50% of tuition fee if fee is more than 12000 Euros.**
- Student Applications lodged 3 weeks or less prior to proposed date of travel will not be processed. The 3 weeks deadline is for the file to reach visa office in New Delhi and

AIP Visa

APPROVAL IN PRINCIPLE SCHEME

- Apply with the conditional offer (pending final year marksheets and provisional degree)
- Student must have paid a **minimum deposit of 6000 Euros.**
- Application to be lodged at least 7 weeks before the course start date.
- Once the final year marksheet and provisional degree has been submitted to the Ireland Embassy, New Delhi, the visa will be issued.

Note: Due to high volume of visa application, we recommend to apply 8 weeks prior to the course start date.



Documents required for Student Visa



Application Forms:

- Printed and signed summary of online application form. The link is- (<https://www.visas.inis.gov.ie/avats/OnlineHome.aspx>)
- Appointment confirmation
- Payment confirmation
- Visa fee of INR 9000 (Multi entry visa) need to be paid online.
- The VFS service fee (INR 3380) need to be paid online.

Passport:

- Original Passport and photocopy of first and last page of the same.
- One recent passport sized photograph not more than 6 months old.
- Student should submit all previous passports along with a photocopy of each page of all the passport(s) submitted.

Original Police Clearance Certificate from Passport Office.



Documents required for Student Visa



Original plus one copy for each of the following documents:

- Acceptance Letter & Confirmation of fees paid
- Statement of Purpose.
- Brief CV.
- Class 10th Mark Sheet & Certificate.
- Class 12th Mark Sheet & Certificate.
- Graduation Mark Sheet & Certificate (In case of PG Course).
- IELTS/PTE score card (any one).
- Letter from Current Employer or Experience Certificate (where applicable).

Financial Documents:

- Affidavit of Support of Sponsor on stamp paper.
- Bank Statement & Bank Balance Certificate (Last 6 Months): Total tuition fees + €10,000 living expenses for each year.
- Bank Loan Sanction Letter and the documents of the property mortgaged with its valuation report (If any).
- Income Tax Return Papers of the sponsor for the last 3 years
- Fixed deposit receipts should be submitted along with Fixed Deposit bank certificate (On bank letter head)



Details on GARDA Registration

Initially, student will be getting visa for 30 to 90 days. Student will have to register at the **Garda National Immigration Bureau (GNIB)** soon after the student arrives in Ireland.

The below documents are required:

- Passport
- Student ID card (provided by the school/university in Ireland).
- A letter from the Registrar's office of the school/university stating that student is a registered student and stating the start date and completion date of his/her course.
- The student is required to show a part of his/her living expenses i.e. a minimum of €3000 to the visa office in his/her Irish bank statement.
- A €300 fee (credit/debit card - no cash accepted).
