About Netherlands

- ▶ The name Netherlands literally meaning "Lower Countries" came about due to its low land and flat geography with only about 50% of its land exceeding one meter above the sea level.
- ▶ Most of the areas are below sea level and are man-made.
- ▶ Since the late 16th century, large areas (polders) have been reclaimed from the sea and lakes amounting to nearly 17% of the country's current land mass.
- ▶ The Netherlands covers around 41,000 square kilometers and has a population of about 16 million.
- ▶ Country with one of the highest English speaking population in Europe (above 90%).
- ▶ With a rich cultural heritage the country has been home to many of history's most famous names in the areas of Art, Literature, Philosophy and Science. It also has a long history of international trade having forged links with countries around the world, bringing together knowledge, skills, business and ideas.



About Netherlands

- ▶ The Netherlands consists of twelve provinces of which two of the provinces North Netherlands and South Netherlands are the most densely populated and encompass the popular cities of Amsterdam, Rotterdam and The Hague.
- ▶ Dutch is the official and predominant spoken language in Netherlands.
- ▶ Euro is the official currency of Netherlands.

- ▶ **Quality Education-**
Educational opportunities of the highest standards and a multicultural population.
- ▶ **Post study work visa**
1 year (for all bachelor's and Master's program)
- ▶ **Courses taught in English**
The Universities of Netherlands charge comparatively low tuition fees from international students and offer Master's programs exclusively taught in English.
- ▶ **Part time Jobs**
Students can work up to 16 hours/week. Typical part time earning are €9 to €12 per hour.
- ▶ **Employment**
Netherlands is counted amongst one of the most industrialized countries in the world. Post study work Visa of 1 year is offered to the students to take up a job and gain international exposure after completion of their studies.

Intake & Deadline



▶ **Intakes:**

Winter - September / October

Summer - February

▶ **General Deadline for Applications:**

Winter - 1st May

Summer - 1st October/1st November

For Numerus Fixus program 15th January (For Winter Intake) is the deadline.



Entry Requirements

Direct Entry to Bachelor's or Master's:

Academic percentage--

- 60-65% and above in previous education. (High ranked Universities may need 70% and above)
- Mathematics is a mandatory requirement for applying to a Bachelor's program other than for courses relating to the Arts stream.
- GMAT is required for an MBA in high ranked universities.

IELTS-

- Masters: 6.5 with no band less than 6.0
- Bachelors: 6.0 with no band less than 5.5

(Some programs may need a higher IELTS score of 6.5)

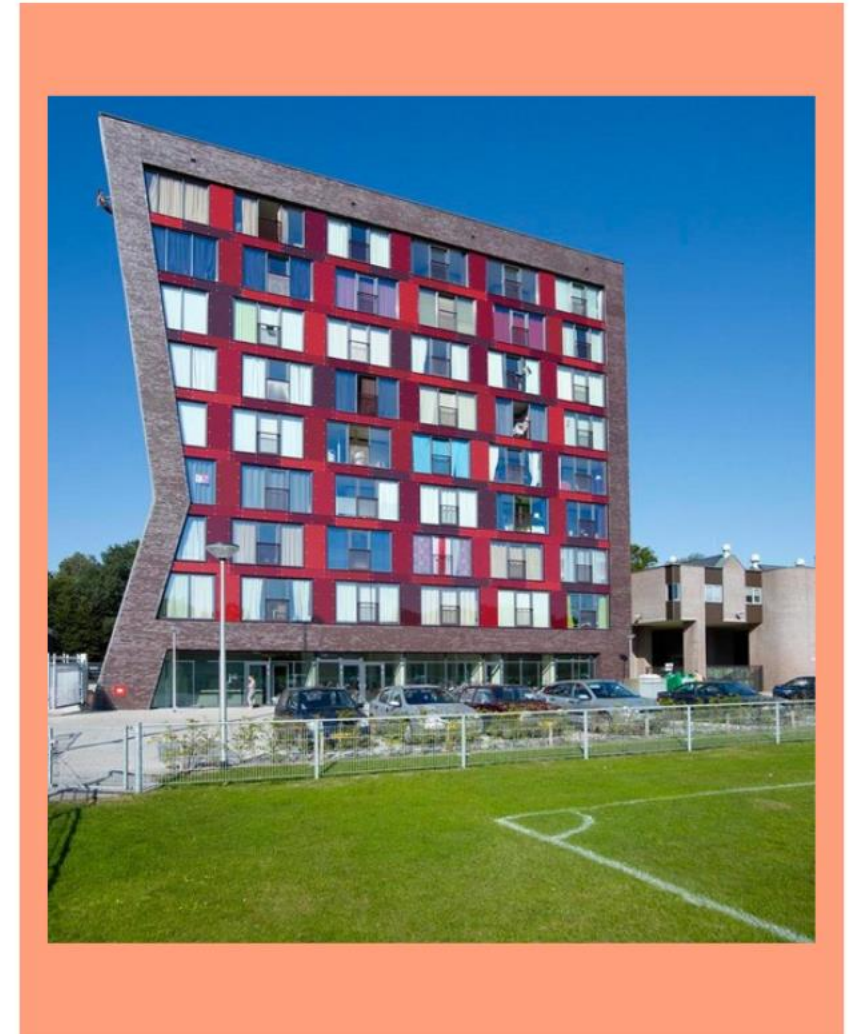

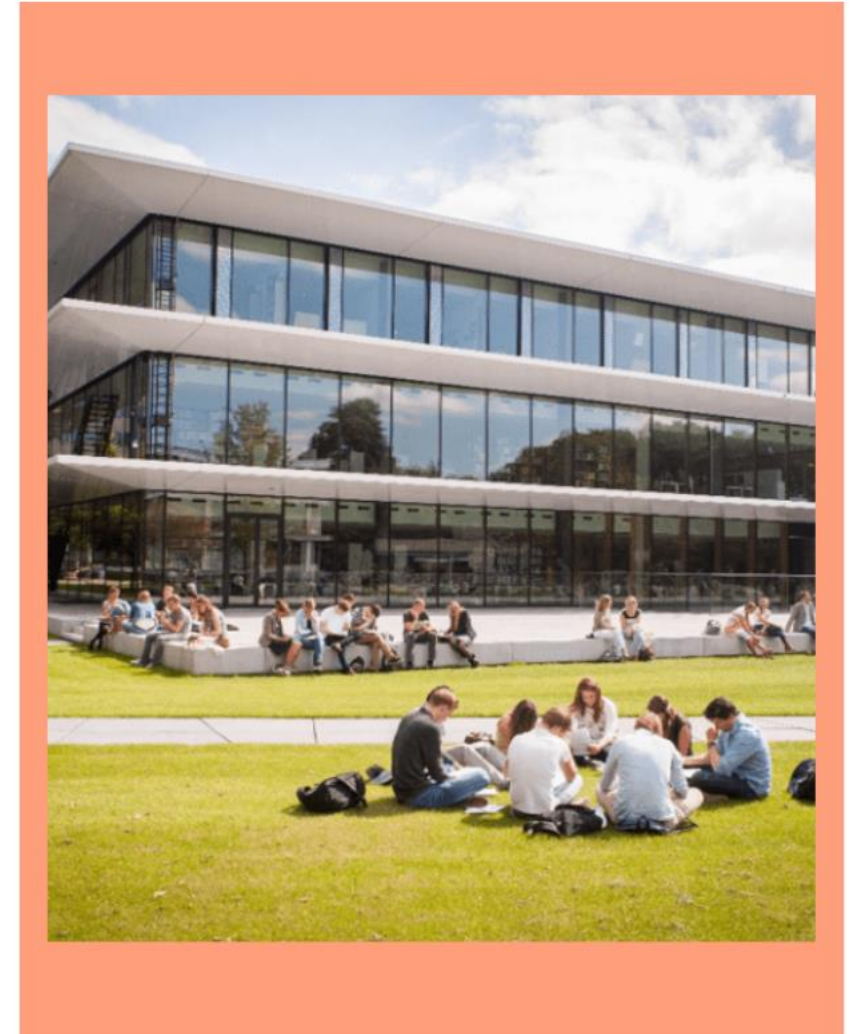
Salient Features Partnered Institutions

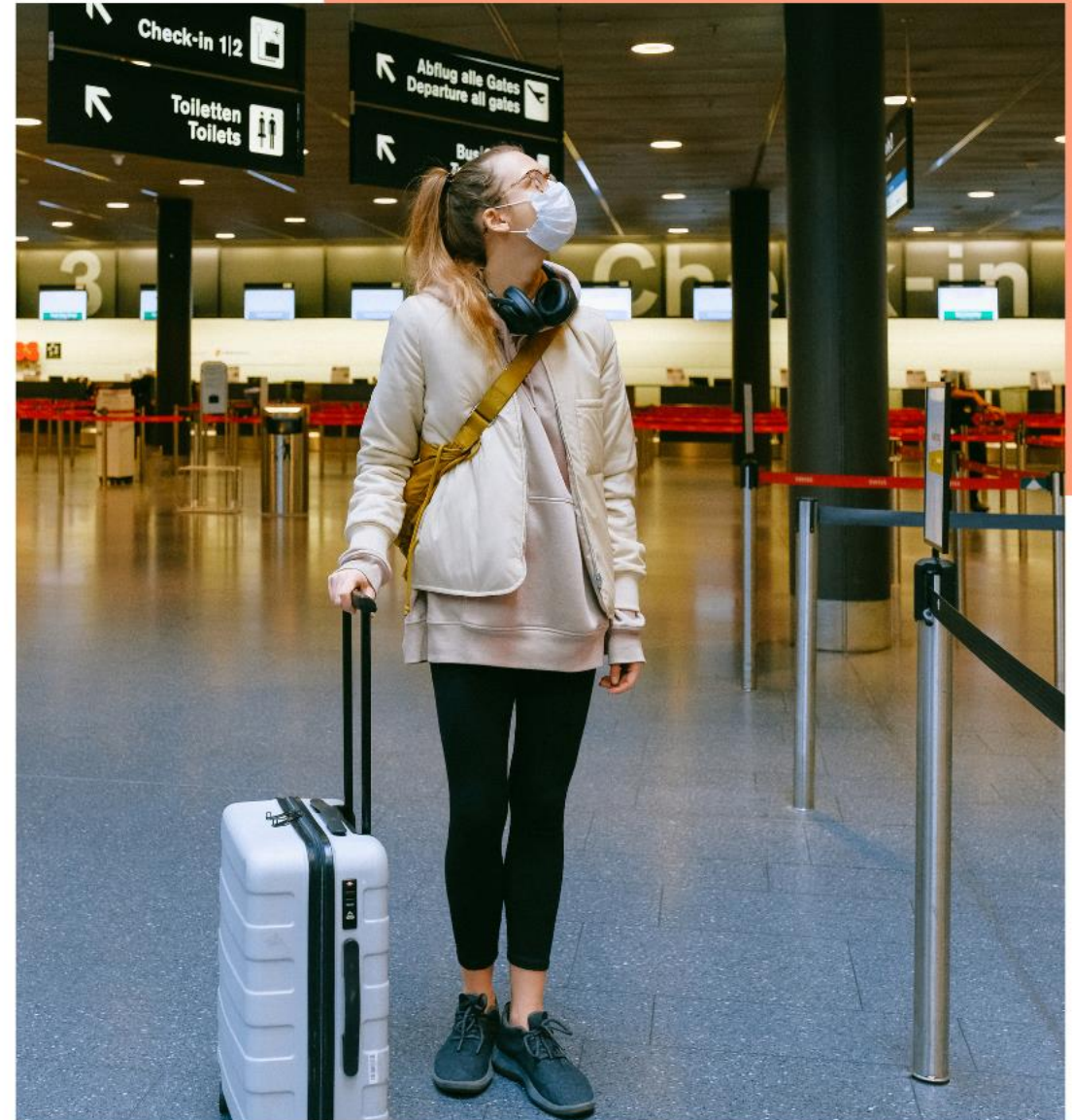

Visa Process

- ▶ Nationals of countries outside the EU who wish to come to the Netherlands for a stay of more than three months need an authorization for temporary stay (MVV).
- ▶ The University will process the visa application (MVV) by applying for the same in the Netherlands on behalf of the students.
- ▶ Visa shall be received in around 2 to 6 weeks. Student needs to go for Biometrics at the local Embassy.
- ▶ On arriving in the Netherlands the University will apply for a residence permit on behalf of the student.
- ▶ The Fees for Visa and residence permit application is usually included in the University Tuition fees package which is approx. € 174



Documents Required for Visa

- Duly filled and signed visa application form (MVV form).
- Duly filled and signed Antecedent Certificate.
- Duly filled and signed Declaration TB Test Form.
- Valid Passport.
- Two color photographs (35-45 mm) of the applicant with white background.
- Offer letter of the Institution duly signed and stamped by an authorized person of the Institution. Letter needs to be in English/Dutch for Visa.
- Prearranged accommodation proof.
- Bank Statement indicating that the student possesses sufficient means of subsistence for the duration of the intended stay of approximately €11,500.
- Duly filled and signed letter from Sponsor (if the funds are shown other than of student's account).
- ID Proof of Sponsors.
- Income tax returns of sponsor's for the last two assessment years.



Frequently Asked Questions

Ques: What will be the budget for a student going to study a Masters' in Netherlands?

Ans: Euro 15,000 to 20,000 approx.

Ques: Do Institutions accept a 3 years Bachelor's or 15 years of education for a Master's?

Ans : Yes, it is accepted.

Ques: Can a student apply without an IELTS score and a final year/12th marksheet for a conditional offer letter?

Ans: Yes, a student can receive a conditional admit but the IELTS date blocking confirmation email (some university do not accept) and Bonafide Certificate from the institution where the student is currently pursuing his/her education will be required to be included in the application.



Frequently Asked Questions

Ques: Are backlogs accepted by Dutch universities?

Ans: No (can accept on trial basis)

Ques: A student completed his Bachelor's degree in 2010 and is working since then. He has a total work experience of 9 years. Can the student apply for a Masters' course?

Ans: Yes

Ques: Can IELTS be waived off in Netherlands?

Ans: No, IELTS is a mandatory requirement.

Ques : If a student has already completed a Master's and would like to pursue a second Master's program in Netherlands, is it possible?

Ans : Yes, a student can apply for a second Master's in Netherlands.



Frequently Asked Questions

Ques: What is the turnaround time for Offer letters from Institutions?

Ans : The turnaround time is around 3 to 6 weeks.

Ques: How much funds does the student need to show at the time of filing visa ? Which funds are acceptable for filing visa ?

Ans: Total tuition fees + living expenses (Euro 11,500 for a year)
