# **Entry requirements**

Medium of Instruction – English and IELTS – Not required ur

Student must be fluent in English with good communication

Academic percentage – above 55% both for UG and PG.

Application Fees- Institutions may have application fees of around 200 EUR (Vistula University).



# **Duration & Tuition Fees**



### **Duration:**

- ➤ Bachelors courses are for 3 years or 4 years depending on the course.
- > Masters courses generally have a duration ranging between one to two years.


### Fees:

Most of the Bachelors and Masters courses costs between Euro 2000-4500 per year (Rs.1.4 lakhs to Rs.3.15 Lakhs per year).

# **Application Documents**

### Documents required for making an application:

- 1. CV/Resume
- 2. Academic Documents 10<sup>th</sup> onwards
- 3. Degree Certificate
- 4. Copy of Passport first and last page
- 5. Work experience letters (if applicable)

All these documents are required in soft for making an application.

### **Please Note:**

 We have an application processing charge of Rs.5000 + 18% GST (non-refundable) per applicant for (2 applications) Poland without Visa Assistance, which is receivable by us once the offer letter is received.

You can apply for a D-type national visa to enter Poland for more than 90 days. Full details are available on the Polish Ministry of Foreign Affairs' Visas page

# **General Visa Guidelines**

### **Documentation**

To submit your D-Visa application, you can register with E-KONSULAT (<a href="https://secure.e-konsulat.gov.pl/">https://secure.e-konsulat.gov.pl/</a>). You will need:

- > A current passport
- > A photograph
- ➤ A filled out and signed visa application
- Proof of visa payment
- ➤ Medical travel insurance, with coverage of at least EUR 30,000

Other supporting documents (including but not limited to purpose of travel, proof of finances, and more confirming other circumstances referred to in the visa application). The full list is on the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Visa website (<a href="https://www.gov.pl/web/diplomacy/visas">https://www.gov.pl/web/diplomacy/visas</a>).

You will then require a Temporary Residence Permit.



# **Proof of Resources**

### Amount of Funds to be shown:

Liquid assets to be shown is the sum total of the amount of tuition fees + a minimum of 650 Euros per month multiplied by number of months of stay (living expenses). In case the course duration is 12 months or more, then living expenses are to be shown for only 1 year.

### **Acceptable Funds:**

- Balance in Savings Account (1 day older Funds)
- Fixed Deposit Bank Loan certification

**Note:** 100 % funds can be shown through blood relatives. Third Party can show Funds upto 30%. There should not be more then 2 sponsors.



# Visa Fees

The above mentioned Visa Fee can be paid in cash or card.

### **VFS Service charge:**

Along with the visa fees, there is a service charge of INR 986/- (All VFS's service charges are inclusive of Goods and Service Tax –SGST @ 9% and CGST @ 9%)) is applicable per visa application and is mandatory to make payment online at the time of booking appointment.

### Please Note:

The applicable visa fee in Indian Rupees is as per the current exchange rate. The same is subject to change without notice.

The Visa fee and service charges are non-refundable in case the visa is refused.

There is an optional courier facility available at Rs. 628/- (Inclusive of Goods and Service Tax –SGST @9% 1 and CGST@9%) per application / passport.
